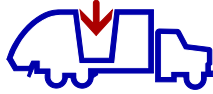

## HELPFUL TRASH/RECYCLING GUIDANCE

In an effort to help keep property values up and reduce or eliminate potential trash/recycling related problems at Churchill East Village, this reminder is to help acquaint you with the appropriate disposal methods. With your help, we can reduce the approximate \$8,000 annual cost to have common area trash removed that the trash company is not responsible to pick up.

### REGULAR TRASH COLLECTION:



- Regular trash collection days are **Mondays and Thursdays.**

✓ *Trash should be placed out **no earlier than 8:00 p.m.** on **Sunday** and **Wednesday** evenings.*

Regular collections will be made when a holiday falls on a Monday or Thursday. **When the holidays below fall on a Monday or Thursday, trash pickup will occur the next day (Tuesday or Friday).**

- The collection point for trash is:*

The curb nearest the front of your home.

- Trash containers **MAY NOT** be stored in front of the homes.*

Trash containers and recycle bins should be stored in your rear yard.

- Trash should be kept in tightly **sealed** metal or rubber containers.

**Please Note:** Trash cans are recommended in lieu of plastic bags to eliminate the potential for animals or weather to scatter trash about and to eliminate unsanitary conditions in our community. Plus, it affects fees if we have to continually pay for someone to pick up trash that escapes from bags.

- PLEASE DO NOT** place large furniture items out for the regular trash collections as the trash company will not remove this type of item. If you have a large item such as a mattress or sofa that needs immediate disposal, please contact Ecology Services at (301)330-3207 to arrange for a special pick-up - you may be billed for this cost!

- Major appliances can be recycled and will be picked up for free by Montgomery County if you call 240-777-0311 (MC311). Please call in advance of your regular recycling day and do not leave appliances on the common area without having arranged for collection.

- Hazardous materials also cannot be picked up by our Trash service—you may dispose of these items at the County Waste Transfer Station in Gaithersburg. Please contact Montgomery County @ 240-777-0311 (MC311) for additional information or go to the County website

### RECYCLING COLLECTION:



- The regular recycling collection day is **MONDAY**.

- The collection point for recycling is the curb at the front of each home.

- Recyclables must be placed in the “blue bin” provided by Montgomery County.

select “**Government**”, then “**Departments**” then “**Environmental Protection**”.

- Yard Waste:** Yard waste must be placed in paper bags or a trash can labeled, “YARD TRIM.” Free labels are available at the library. Tree limbs or branches must be cut in 4 foot lengths, bundled, and tied with twine. **NEVER PUT YARD WASTE IN PLASTIC BAGS!**

### What goes in your blue bin?

- \* **Newspapers & card board boxes:**

Newspapers: must be in a **paper** bag or tied in a bundle.

Card board boxes: must be flat.

- \* **Glass bottles and jars:**

**EXAMPLE:** Soda, juice, beer and wine bottles, salad dressing, pickle, mayonnaise jars, etc.

- \* **Aluminum and tin cans:**

**EXAMPLE:** Soda, beer and juice cans, pet food, tuna and vegetable cans, including **CLEAN** aluminum foil products such as TV dinner trays, pie plates and aluminum foil wrap.

- \* **Plastic “bottles”:**

**EXAMPLES:** Milk, soda, water and juice bottles, dish soap, laundry detergent and bleach bottles.

- You Should:

- \* **EMPTY AND RINSE** all containers to be recycled.

- \* **DISCARD** the caps and lids.

- \* **STORE** recyclables in a designated container **inside your home**.

Trash and recycling containers left out after regular trash pickup will be removed from the property and discarded.  
Containers may not be stored in the front the home.
